Board Member Conflict of Interest

No Board of Education member shall have a beneficial interest directly or indirectly in any contract, work, or business of the District unless permitted by State law.

Board members must annually file a *Statement of Economic Interests* as required by the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act. Each Board member is responsible for filing the statement with the county clerk of the county in which the District's main office is located by May 1.

1. It is the declared purpose of this policy that the Board of Education of School District 167 maintain accountability with the community it serves. To that end, no Board member will have a pecuniary interest in any contract, work or business of the District unless permitted by the School Code.
2. In order to insure all applicants fair employment opportunities, no Board of Education member will be employed by Brookwood School District 167 prior to one year after completion of their term of office or resignation from the Board.
