Name Of Assessment	What Is Measured Purpose	Timeframe Schedule When The Assessment Is Administered
<p>AIMSweb</p> <p>R-CBM</p> <p>M-COMP</p>	<p>Used to efficiently and quickly assess our students' reading skills. The assessment data is collected and entered into the AIMSweb system. The data is used to identify students who may need additional support or additional diagnostic assessment. By using this universal screener three times per year, we can identify students who are "on track" with reading, and also identify students who may need additional support to meet reading goals. Many students, who are identified to receive additional targeted instruction, are progress monitored (tested weekly) to ensure they are making adequate progress. Every day we have intervention time for students. This intervention allows students to receive support and/or enrichment based on individual needs.</p> <p>At Brookwood Jr. High School, students will be given the R-CBM, and the M-COMP.</p> <p>R-CBM The R-CBM is a one minute timed fluency test. Students read three one-minute passages and a median score is taken.</p> <p>M-COMP This 8-10 minute assessment measures students' math foundation/computation skills such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complex Computation • Decimals • Fractions • Conversions • Equations • Percentages • Integers • Expressions • Reductions • Exponents 	<p>Benchmark Assessment Windows</p> <p>Fall: September 14 September 25</p> <p>Winter: January 5 January 16</p> <p>Progress Monitoring: Weekly And / Or Biweekly Tier 2 & Tier 3 Interventions</p>

PARCC ELA & Mathematics	<p>The Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) is a group of states—including Illinois—that have come together to develop high-quality student assessments aligned with the new Common Core State Standards in English language arts / literacy and mathematics.</p> <p>These computer delivered assessments will replace the ISAT state assessment in those subjects. PARCC assessments are different from the ISAT. For example, PARCC assessments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask students to read real-life texts and solve meaningful problems based on high-quality classroom work. Provide information about students' academic achievement—what they are doing well and where improvement is needed. Show whether students are on track for success in college or a career.
