Below is the requested information from Brookwood Jr. High School:

Our AIMSwebb was administered only in the Fall of 2014 (September, 2014) as a screener to determine intervention groups. The data showed that a little more than 50% of 7th grade students scored above the target for reading comprehension and 65% of 8th grade students scored above the target for reading comprehension. In mathematics, 75% of incoming 7th grade students were below the target level in mathematics concepts and applications. 45% of 8th grade students scored above the target.

Based on the AIMSwebb results, students did receive intervention in both reading and mathematics. We primarily used direct instruction and Study Island.

**We will be finishing all NWEA make-ups on Monday, June 1, 2015. We will be conducting a final analysis comparing benchmark data when reports are available.*
